

# MESSIANIC PROPHECY—JOB, SAMUEL, PROVERBS

## Book of Job

- **“Arbitrator”**- "Nor is there an arbiter between us, who might lay his hand on us both," (Job 9:33 NET); **NT**- "My little children, I am writing these things to you so that you may not sin. And if anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous" (1 John 2:1)
- **“Witness”**- "Even now my witness is in heaven; my advocate is on high. My intercessor is my friend as my eyes pour out tears to God; and he contends with God on behalf of man as a man pleads for his friend." (Job 16:19-21 NET); **NT**- "Therefore He is able also to save forever those who draw near to God through Him, since He always lives to make intercession for them." (Heb 7:25); **NT**- "who is the one who condemns? Christ Jesus is He who died, yes, rather who was raised, who is at the right hand of God, who also intercedes for us." (Romans 8:34)
- **“Redeemer”**- "O that my words were written down, O that they were written on a scroll, that with an iron chisel and with lead they were engraved in a rock forever! As for me, I know that my Redeemer lives, and that as the last he will stand upon the earth. And after my skin has been destroyed, yet in my flesh I will see God, whom I will see for myself, and whom my own eyes will behold, and not another. My heart grows faint within me." (Job 19:23-27 NET); **NT**- "and not through the blood of goats and calves, but through His own blood, He entered the holy place once for all, having obtained eternal redemption." (Hebrews 9:12)
- **“Mediator”**- " If there is an angel beside him, one mediator out of a thousand, to tell a person what constitutes his uprightness; and if God is gracious to him and says, 'Spare him from going down to the place of corruption, I have found a ransom for him,' then his flesh is restored like a youth's; he returns to the days of his youthful vigor. He entreats God, and God delights in him, he sees God's face with rejoicing, and God restores to him his righteousness. That person sings to others, saying: 'I have sinned and falsified what is right, but I was not punished according to what I deserved. He redeemed my life from going down to the place of corruption, and my life sees the light!'" (Job 33:23-28 NET); **NT**- "For there is one God, and one mediator also between God and men, the man Christ Jesus" (1 Timothy 2:5).

## 1 Samuel 2:10

"Those who contend with the LORD will be shattered; Against them He will thunder in the heavens, The LORD will judge the ends of the earth; And He will give strength to His king, And will exalt the horn of His anointed (Messiah [NAU])."

- Messiah will be king

## 1 Samuel 2:35

"But I will raise up for Myself a faithful priest who will do according to what is in My heart and in My soul; and I will build him an enduring house, and he (it) will walk before My anointed always" (NAU)

- The Messiah will be a priest with an eternal house (cf. Hebrews 3:5-6; John 8:29; 1 Peter 2:9; Revelation 1:6; Psalm 110)

## **2 Samuel 7:11b-16 (1 Chronicles 17:10b-14)**

"even from the day that I commanded judges *to be* over My people Israel. And I will subdue all your enemies. Moreover, I tell you that the LORD will build a house for you. "When your days are fulfilled that you must go *to be* with your fathers, that I will set up *one of* your descendants after you, who will be of your sons; and I will establish his kingdom. "He shall build for Me a house, and I will establish his throne forever. "I will be his father and he shall be My son; and I will not take My lovingkindness away from him, as I took it from him who was before you. "But I will settle him in My house and in My kingdom forever, and his throne shall be established forever." (1Chronicles 17:10-14 NAU)

- The Messiah would be king
- The Messiah would have eternal throne and house
- The Messiah would be son of David (Matt 22:42; 1:1; Luke 3:31; Jeremiah 22:30; Ezra 2:61; Nehemiah 7:63; Mary son of Heli- Babylonian Talmud- Sanhedrin 44:2)

## **Proverbs 30:4**

"Who has ascended into heaven and descended? Who has gathered the wind in His fists? Who has wrapped the waters in His garment? Who has established all the ends of the earth? What is His name or His son's name? Surely you know!" (NAU)

- The Messiah would be the Son of God (Luke 1:35; John 1:34; John 10:36; 11:4)
