

MESSIANIC PROPHECY—SAMUEL, PSALMS

2 Samuel 7:11b-16 (1 Chronicles 17:10b-14)

"even from the day that I commanded judges *to be* over My people Israel. And I will subdue all your enemies. Moreover, I tell you that the LORD will build a house for you. "When your days are fulfilled that you must go *to be* with your fathers, that I will set up *one of* your descendants after you, who will be of your sons; and I will establish his kingdom. "He shall build for Me a house, and I will establish his throne forever. "I will be his father and he shall be My son; and I will not take My lovingkindness away from him, as I took it from him who was before you. "But I will settle him in My house and in My kingdom forever, and his throne shall be established forever." (1Chronicles 17:10-14 NAU)

- The Messiah would be king
- The Messiah would be eternal Himself
- The Messiah would have eternal throne and house
- The Messiah would be son of David (Matt 22:42; 1:1; Luke 3:31; Jeremiah 22:30; Ezra 2:61; Nehemiah 7:63; Mary son of Heli- Babylonian Talmud- Sanhedrin 44:2)
- Genealogy in Matthew 1 is Joseph's based on context of Matthew writing about Joseph's thoughts, actions, etc.; Provides basis for Jesus not being son of Joseph and need for a virgin birth.
- Genealogy in Luke 3 is Mary's based on context of Luke writing about Mary's thoughts, actions, etc. (see *Harmony of the Gospels* by John Broadus, Revised by A.T. Robertson, [pp. 267-268], 1903; you can find it for free on books.google.com)

Psalm 2:7-12

"I will surely tell of the decree of the LORD: He said to Me, 'You are My Son, Today I have begotten You. 8 'Ask of Me, and I will surely give the nations as Your inheritance, And the *very* ends of the earth as Your possession. 9 'You shall break them with a rod of iron, You shall shatter them like earthenware.'" 10 Now therefore, O kings, show discernment; Take warning, O judges of the earth. 11 Worship the LORD with reverence And rejoice with trembling. 12 Do homage to the Son, that He not become angry, and you perish *in* the way, For His wrath may soon be kindled. How blessed are all who take refuge in Him!"

- Messiah would be Son of God (Proverbs 30:4; Isaiah 9:6; Luke 1:35; Matt 4:3; Mark 3:11; Luke 22:7; John 10:36)
- Messiah will be a king in Jerusalem
- Messiah will rule over all the Gentiles and end of the earth (Rom 8:17; Rev 1:6)
- Messiah will be trusted in (cf. Genesis 49:6; John 14:1)
- Psalm 2 fulfilled in Jesus (Acts 4:25-27; 13:33; Heb 1:5; 5:5; Rev 2:26-27; 12:5; 19:15)

"**Acts 4:25** who by the Holy Spirit, *through* the mouth of our father David Your servant, said, 'WHY DID THE GENTILES RAGE, AND THE PEOPLES DEVISE FUTILE THINGS? 26 'THE KINGS OF THE EARTH TOOK THEIR STAND, AND THE RULERS WERE GATHERED TOGETHER AGAINST THE LORD AND AGAINST HIS CHRIST.' 27 "For truly in this city there were gathered together against Your holy servant Jesus, whom You anointed, both Herod and Pontius Pilate, along with the Gentiles and the peoples of Israel," (Act 4:25-27)

"**Acts 13:33** that God has fulfilled this *promise* to our children in that He raised up Jesus, as it is also written in the second Psalm, 'YOU ARE MY SON; TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU.'" (Act 13:33)

"**Hebrews 1:5** For to which of the angels did He ever say, "YOU ARE MY SON, TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU"? And again, "I WILL BE A FATHER TO HIM AND HE SHALL BE A SON TO ME"?" (Heb 1:5)

"**Hebrews 5:5** So also Christ did not glorify Himself so as to become a high priest, but He who said to Him, "YOU ARE MY SON, TODAY I HAVE BEGOTTEN YOU";" (Heb 5:5)

"**Revelation 2:26** 'He who overcomes, and he who keeps My deeds until the end, TO HIM I WILL GIVE AUTHORITY OVER THE NATIONS; 27 AND HE SHALL RULE THEM WITH A ROD OF IRON, AS THE VESSELS OF THE POTTER ARE BROKEN TO PIECES, as I also have received *authority* from My Father;" (Rev 2:26-27)

"**Revelation 12:5** And she gave birth to a son, a male *child*, who is to rule all the nations with a rod of iron; and her child was caught up to God and to His throne." (Rev 12:5)

"**Revelation 19:15** From His mouth comes a sharp sword, so that with it He may strike down the nations, and He will rule them with a rod of iron; and He treads the wine press of the fierce wrath of God, the Almighty." (Rev 19:15)
