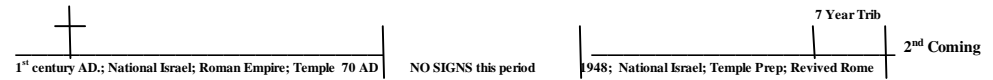


“The Coming Tribulation Temple” 4/19/09
Matthew 24:15



POINT 1- To understand the coming temple we need to know the BACKGROUND

- A. The necessity of a rebuilt temple includes the abomination of DESOLATION (Matthew 24:1-25; Daniel 11:31; 12:11; Mark 13:14; 1 Maccabees 1:54)
- B. The necessity of a rebuilt temple includes the removal of SACRIFICES (Daniel 9:24-27; Isaiah 28:15-18)
- C. The necessity of a rebuilt temple includes the Anti-Christ's VISIT (2 Thessalonians 2:1-13)
- D. The necessity of a rebuilt temple includes the trampling by GENTILES (Revelation 11:1-2)

Going Deeper God wants you to know that He has given us these truths for a purpose!

POINT 2- To understand the coming temple we need to know the CURRENT STATUS

- A. The current status of the temple includes tremendous PREPARATIONS (Check out: templeinstitute.com and templemountfaithful.org)
- B. The current status of the temple includes the formation of the SANHEDRIN (Matthew 23:39; Check out: www.thesanhedrin.org/en/ **QUOTE**)

Going Deeper God wants you to know that He is in control of world events!

POINT 3- To understand the coming temple we need to know our RESPONSE

- A. Our response to God's prophetic truths should be zeal and HOLINESS (1 John 2:3-6; 3:3; John 14:15, 21; 1 Peter 1:15-16; 2 Cor 5:2; Rev 22:17)
- B. Our response to God's prophetic truth should be readiness and Expectancy (Mat 24:42-43; 25:10-13; 25:13; Luke 12:39; 19:11-17; 21:36; Rev 3:3)

Going Deeper God wants you to be holy, ready, and proclaiming His Truth!

The Sanhedrin's decision regarding the Holy Temple, the Temple Mount, and Jerusalem

28 Iyar 5765 (May 19, 2004)

The Sanhedrin calls upon all groups who work in the area of Temple and Temple Mount-related research and activity, to begin to prepare detailed architectural plans for the construction of the Holy Temple, towards the goal of its establishment in its proper place.

The Sanhedrin will establish a forum of architects and engineers whose goal will be to implement this decision, so that detailed working plans are effectively brought to an operational stage.

The Sanhedrin calls upon the Jewish people to contribute towards the acquisition of materials for the purpose of rebuilding the Holy Temple; the gathering and preparation of prefabricated, disassembled portions of this building to be stored and ready for rapid assembly, in the manner of King David. These contributions will be consider "chulin," i.e., non-sacred, for the purpose of the planning and construction of the Temple.
